Little Bella Baker, only 5 months old, is suffering from a congenital disease called Intrahepatic Porto Systemic Shunt (IHPSS). Without the procedure to coil her shunt, she will die. The cost of this procedure is close to \$4000 - that is with the DVM donating his time and that of his staff.

Bella must have surgery within the next week or it will be too late.

When I learned of Bella's plight on the 14th of July she needed more than \$3,000 - now that amount is down to only \$1,000.
